Seilmakeren Doublehanded, Bergen–Stavanger–Bergen, is arranged by Askøy Seilforening, which has the technical responsibility and authority for the regatta.

The regatta is organized in co-operation with Stavanger Seilforening og SEILmagasinet.

The distance Bergen–Stavanger–Bergen is sailed, with a three hour pitstop in Stavanger.

Seilmakeren Doublehanded starts on May 7. at 13:00 and will use the LYS handicap system.

The total distance is approximately 180 nautical miles.

1. RULES

The regatta will be sailed under the following rules:

- 1.1 The Announcement of the Regatta and the Notice of Race.
- 1.2 ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2005–2008.
- 1.3 National laws and rules, with the exception of the changes provided for by the rules in these instructions.
- 1.4 The safety requirements of ISAF Special Regulations –2006 –2007 Category 3.
- 1.5 The rules of the LYS-system 2007.
- 1.6 The regatta is classified according to ISAFs Racing Rules of Sailing Appendix 1, Category C, and the advertising rules of the Norwegian Sailing Association apply.
- 1.7 Inspection of safety equipment can take place on any of the boats either before the regatta, during the pitstop or after the regatta.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 The organizer reserves the right to advertising of the sponsor.

3. CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats with a valid LYS-certificate with a LYS-number over 1,11 and that satisfy the ISAF Safety Requirements, Category 3.
- 3.2 Crews must consist of two persons.
- 3.3 Minimum age for the skipper is 21 and for the crew 16 years old.
- 3.4 At least one of the crew must have a valid VHF certificate. There must be two mobile telephones on board.

4. REGATTA OFFICE

- 4.1 The official regatta office will be the club house at Askøy Seilsportsenter.

5. REGISTRATION AT THE REGATTA OFFICE

- Tuesday May 6. from 19:00 to 22:00 hours
Wednesday May 7. from 09:00 to 12:00 hours

6. REGISTRATION

- 6.1 Registration shall be done through:
www.seilmagasinet.no
and registration fees should be paid through Netaxept by VISA or Mastercard. The registration is valid when payment has been approved.
- 6.2 The registration fee is NOK 1500,- (Norwegian kroner).
- 6.3 Those who register before 01.12.2007 receive Two Henry Lloyd Octane jackets with Seilmakeren Doublehanded logo, with a market price of NOK 4000,- per team.
- 6.4 Those who register after 01.12.2007 can buy the Henry Lloyd Seilmakeren Doublehanded jacket at a discount at Seilmaker Iversen AS in Bergen.
- 6.5 All registered teams will receive a regatta flag for the Seilmakeren Doublehanded 2008.
- 6.6 Harbour fees at Askøy and Stavanger are included in the registration fee.
- 6.7 Breakfast before the race and barbecue after the race is over are included.

- 6.8 Paid fees cannot be returned.
- 6.9 Deadline for registration is April 25. 2008.
- 6.10 All boats must inform the organizer of a mobile telephone number that can be used during the regatta and an email address at registration. This will make communication with participating crews easier and make the regatta more media friendly.

7. COURSE

- 7.1 Start at Hauglandosen on Askøy, southward passage under the Sotra Bridge, from there a free choice of way to the pitstop in Stavanger.
- 7.2 From the pitstop in Stavanger a free choice of way, with a northward passage under the Sotra Bridge and to the finish at Hauglandosen on Askøy.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 8.1 Sailing instructions will be published on April 11. 2008.

9. INSURANCE

- 9.1 All participating boats must have a valid third party liability insurance.

10. LIABILITY

- 10.1 Crews participate only at their own responsibility. See RRS 4 – Decision to race. The organizing authorities will accept no liability whatsoever for any personal or material damage (including but not limited to death, injury, consequential damages, etc.) sustained prior to, during or after the regatta.

11. PRIZES

- 11.1 Prizes will be awarded to both members of the participating crews.
- 11.2 Besides, the regatta leaders can decide to award a prize to participants that deserve acknowledgement based on other grounds.
- 11.3 First prize over all: NOK 15.000 worth of articles free of choice at Seilmaker Iversen AS.

12. BOAT RENT
